

CHECKLIST:

RECOGNIZE • AVOID • REPORT

AN ILLEGAL OPERATOR

1) Before use, make sure to check the following:

- Is the organiser included on the Games of Chance Administration's List of Organisers (<https://www.uis.gov.rs/rsc/spisakpnaziv/>)?
- Is there clear information about the organiser (title, seat, contact)?
- Are the rules of the game available and understandable?

2) Recognize the warning signs:

- There is no player's age or identity verification before creating an account
- Unrealistic bonuses and promises ("safe", "unlimited", "guaranteed win")
- Unclear payment terms, permanent deferral, "additional fees" or "additional deposit"
- False "certificates" or "licenses" without a verifiable source

3) Recognise the marketing traps:

- False "tests" and "top lists" that promote the illegal organiser without a stated transparent methodology
- Influencers/channels with audiences among young people promoting the website
- Pressure to play "immediately" or "win back losses"

4) If you come across a suspicious offer:

- Stop using
- Save evidence (URL, screenshot, date/time)
- Report to the Games of Chance Authority
